In May of 2019, Rev. Dale Skinner and Rev. Maryann Skinner are planning to lead a group of travellers on a journey through some of the lands of the Bible. Dale and Maryann have taken multiple journeys to this area and are excited to have the opportunity to do it again. Recent archeology continues to unearth more evidence that confirms Biblical accounts.
